JACQUES BENOIT Agora

Jacques Benoit, who lives and works in Paris, is having a solo exhibition of his work, from November 4 through 29. His large, arresting paintings involve a variety of techniques and materials including oil paint, vinyl paint, linocuts and gouache. Primarily concerned with the human figure, his subjects float throughout other-worldy dimensions in sensual. undulating rhythms. There is a lofty and lyrical quality that emanates in pulsating contrasts of color and shade.

Benoit has been influenced by the music and lyrics of Joni Mitchell, and had the opportunity to show her his works. "Her quest for reaching souls started my own process of touching people through Art, with the urgency to express situations, conflicts, physical temptations and emotions...", says the artist.

Three artists approach this fertile condition with freshness and a sense of exhileration. Primarily, the subjects are of nature. This exhibition runs from October 4 through November 1.

Celina Clavijo lives in Kyoto, Japan, and has won many awards for her delicate and poetic works of art. Her graceful and shimmering etchings and egg tempera on Japanese paper and Sumi Ink wash on Japanese paper, revere flowers and landscapes. She is a teacher of Chinese brush painting.

Kikuko Sheperd paints foliage and birds with masterful brush work. Born in Japan, she studied Sumi-e ink brush painting which imbues her work with her profound sense of balance and harmony. She is equally adept in both watercolor and oil painting.

The mixed media and oil on canvas paintings of Sandra Dee blend realism with a sense of fantasy and sensuality. Romance and spirituality also pervade her quiet and dramatic scenes. Sunsets,
